American Founder of the Sisters of Mercy
1810-1884

Frances and her Sisters endured incredible hardships in moving from Maine to California by Conestoga wagon and ox-cart to establish schools, hospitals, and orphanages where none existed.

The story of the Sisters of Mercy and their ministry under their great leader deserves to be remembered as one of the greatest episodes in the history of the American Church.

Francis Warde and her six Mercy companions made the 3,000-mile journey from Ireland to New York in 1843 on board the Queen of the West. The trip took some 40 days.

The Sisters of Mercy responded to calls throughout Ireland, England, Newfoundland, and the United States of America and eventually travelled to Australia and New Zealand. Today they work in more than 44 countries.

Frances Warde's contribution to United States history between 1843 and 1884 is unique, coming to the United States from Carlow, Ireland, at a crucial point in the development of American cities and of the American Church and hierarchy.
